Too many legal agreements!

- Developing common agreements for intra- and inter-HIO exchange
 - between HIOs and their data sharing partners.
 - among HIOs and HISPs.
- Western States Consortium
 - Pioneering policies, procedures, and technical services for interstate exchange.

Create a trust fabric for private and secure exchange to encourage widespread participation in HIE.

Too many choices!

- Breaking data silos “created” by the EHR incentive program.
 - Supporting future standards through ONC, EHR|HIE Interoperability Workgroup.
 - Bundling existing standards in the “**Orderable Kit**”.
- Demonstrating available capabilities in **California Connects**.

Making it real.

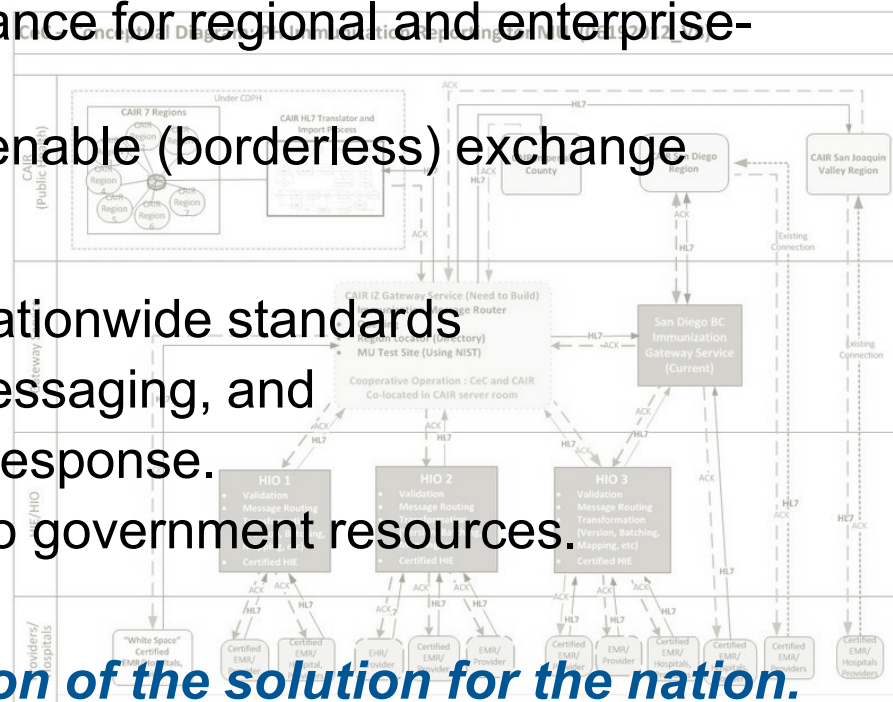

Too many data silos!

- We need choices:
 - Enterprise EHRs providing shared data capture
 - HIOs providing governance for regional and enterprise-wide exchange
 - Service providers that enable (borderless) exchange
- But they need to talk:
 - Promoting the use of nationwide standards
 - Direct for directed messaging, and
 - Exchange for query/response.
 - Developing gateways to government resources.

Too many connections to build!

- Trusted, secure exchange requires
 - knowing my message is not being overheard or garbled,
 - knowing we are talking about the same person, and
 - knowing to whom I'm talking.
- Establish policies, procedures, and standards for federated identity management.
 - A reproducible solution for California, the Western States, and the nation.

The nation has the same problems we solving here in California.



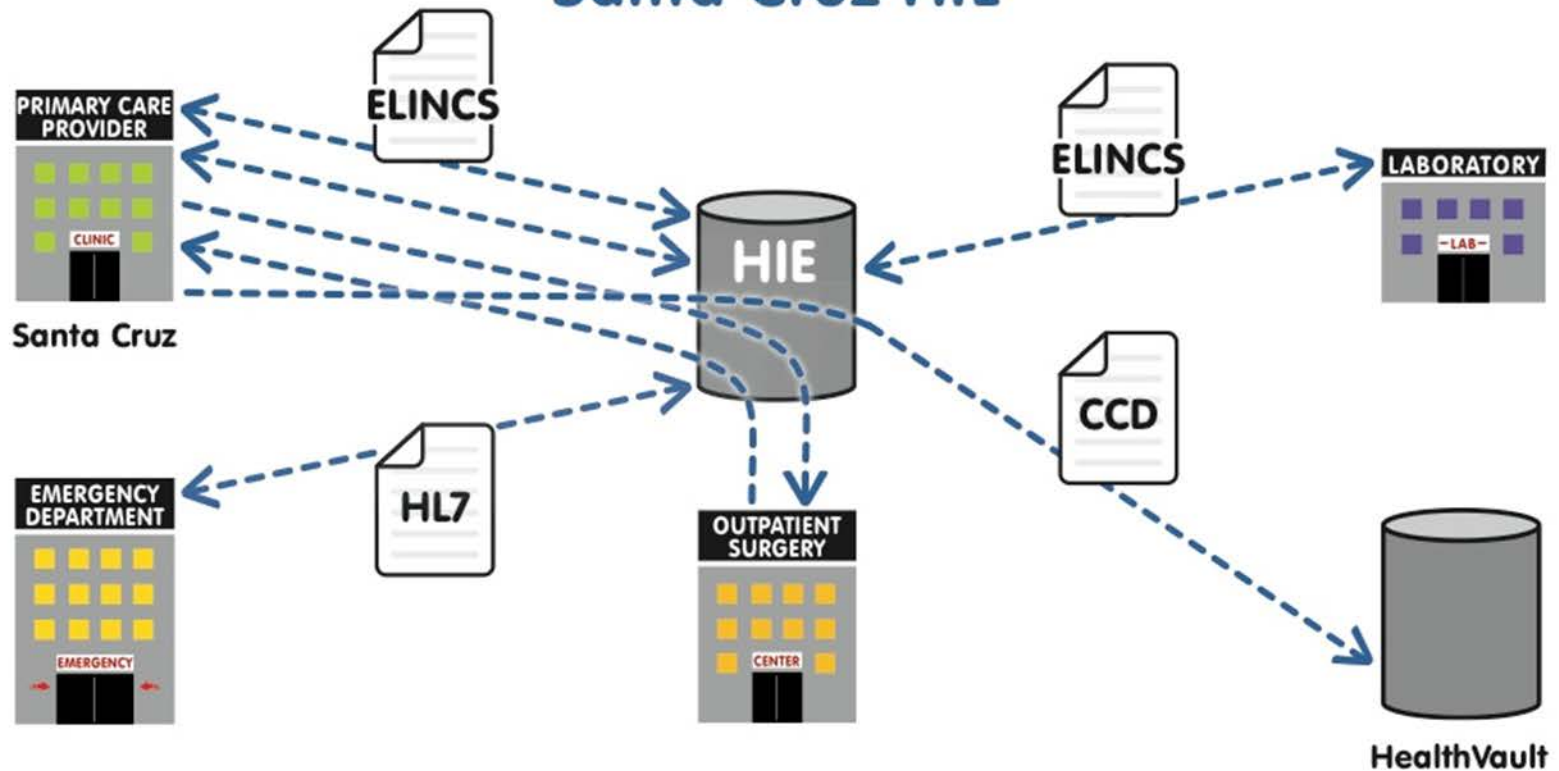

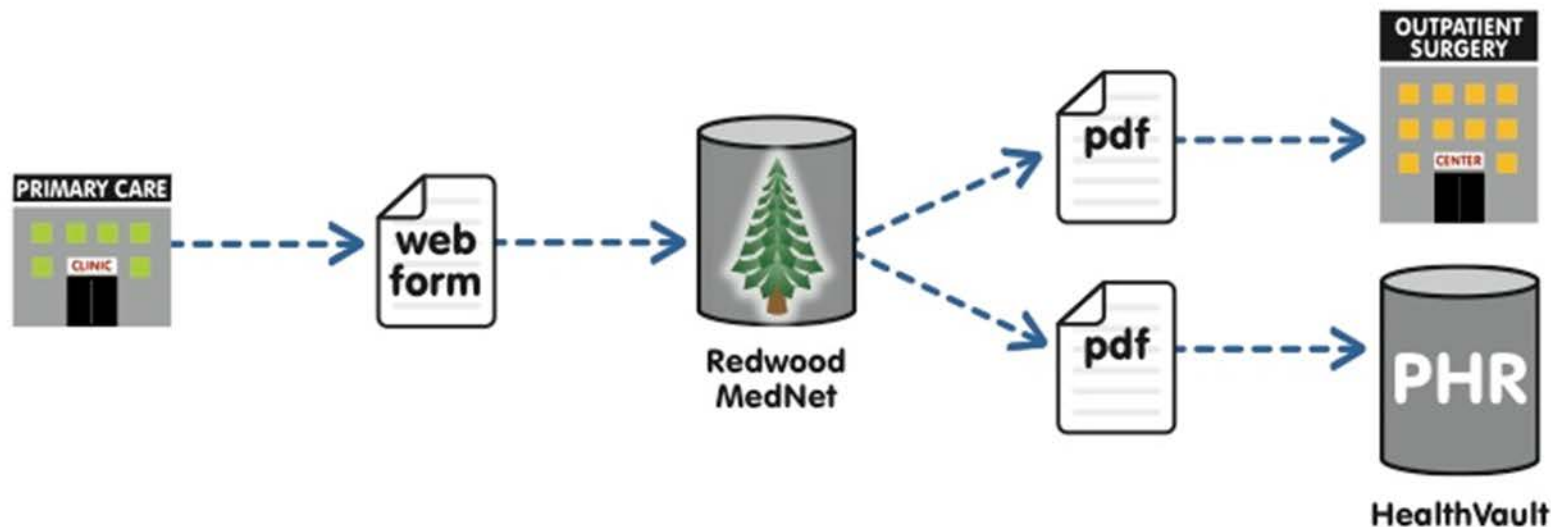
HIE Supports Care Coordination Among Multiple Providers

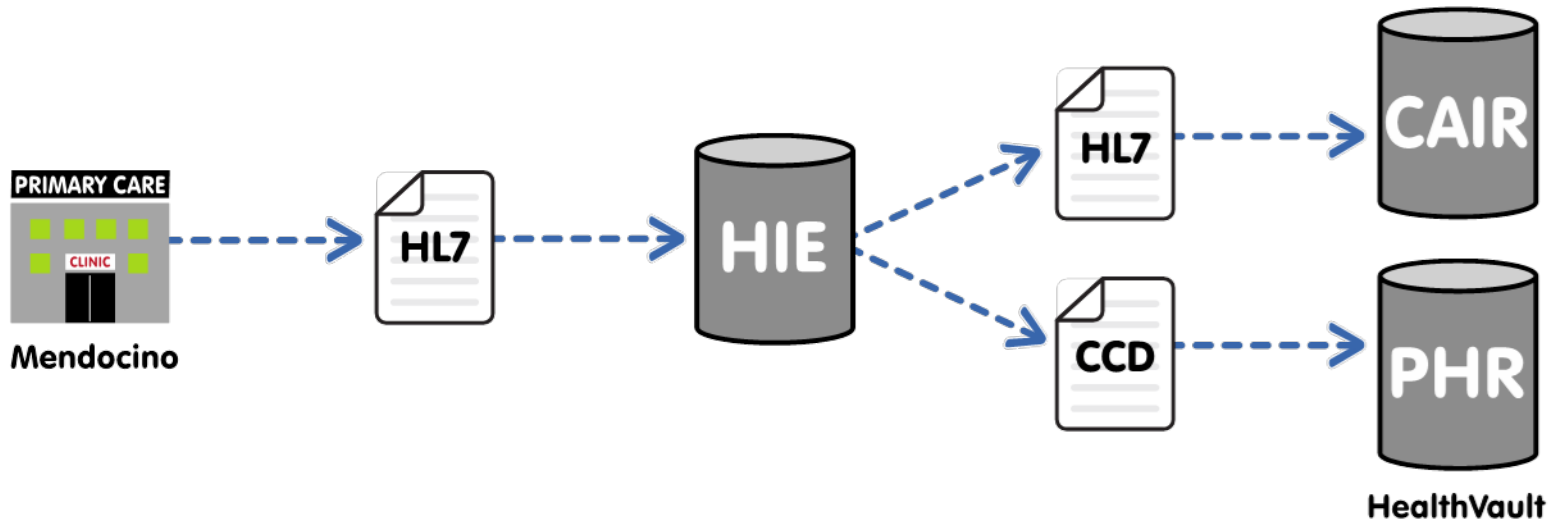


Primary Care Sends Pre-Op Physical to Outpatient Surgery Center
