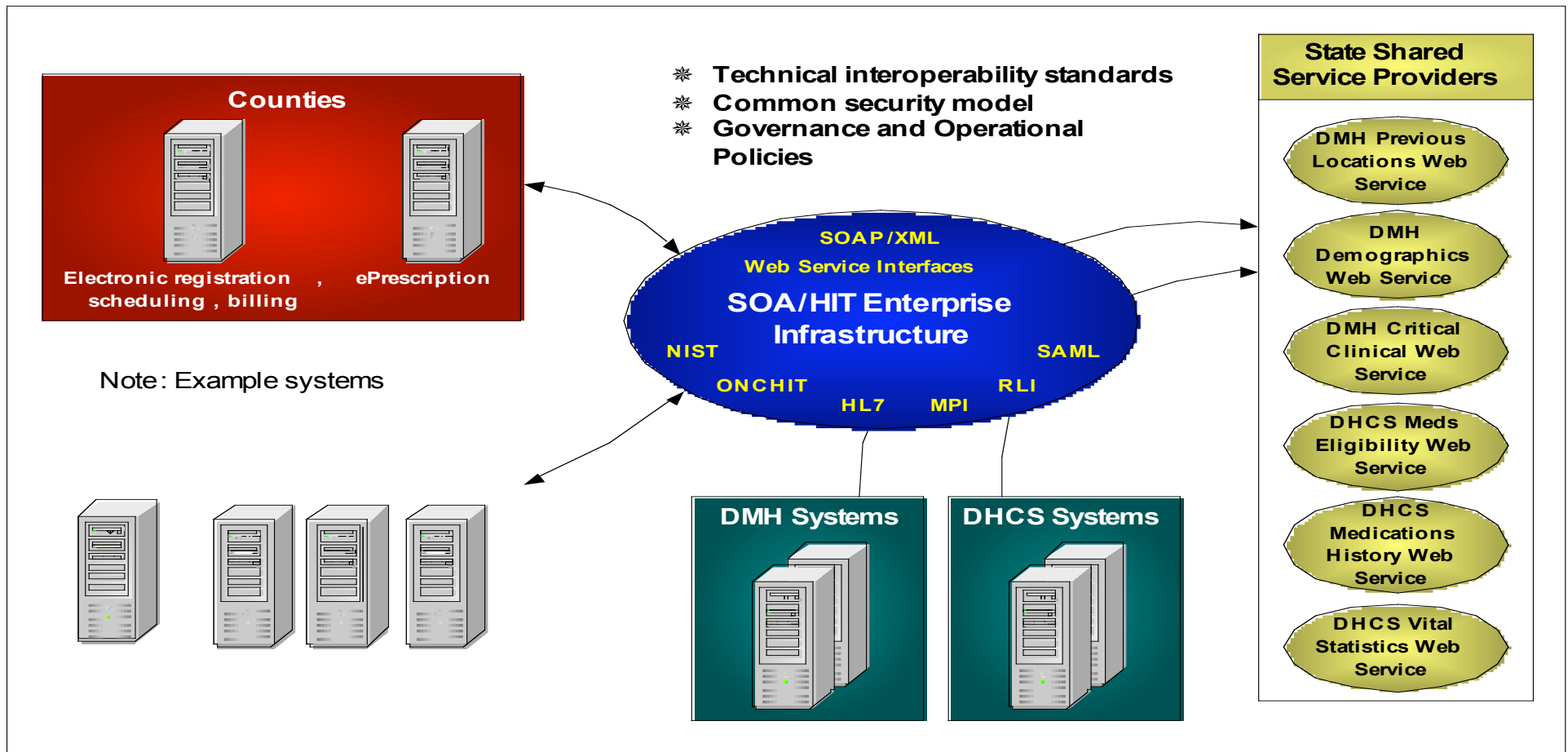

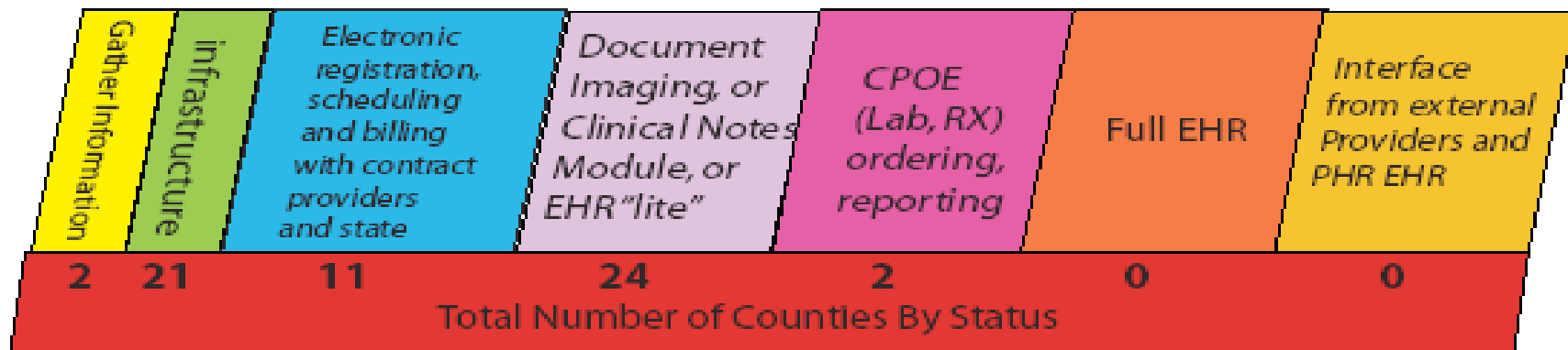
Concept for State Enterprise HIE Vision

County Baseline EHR Implementation Status:

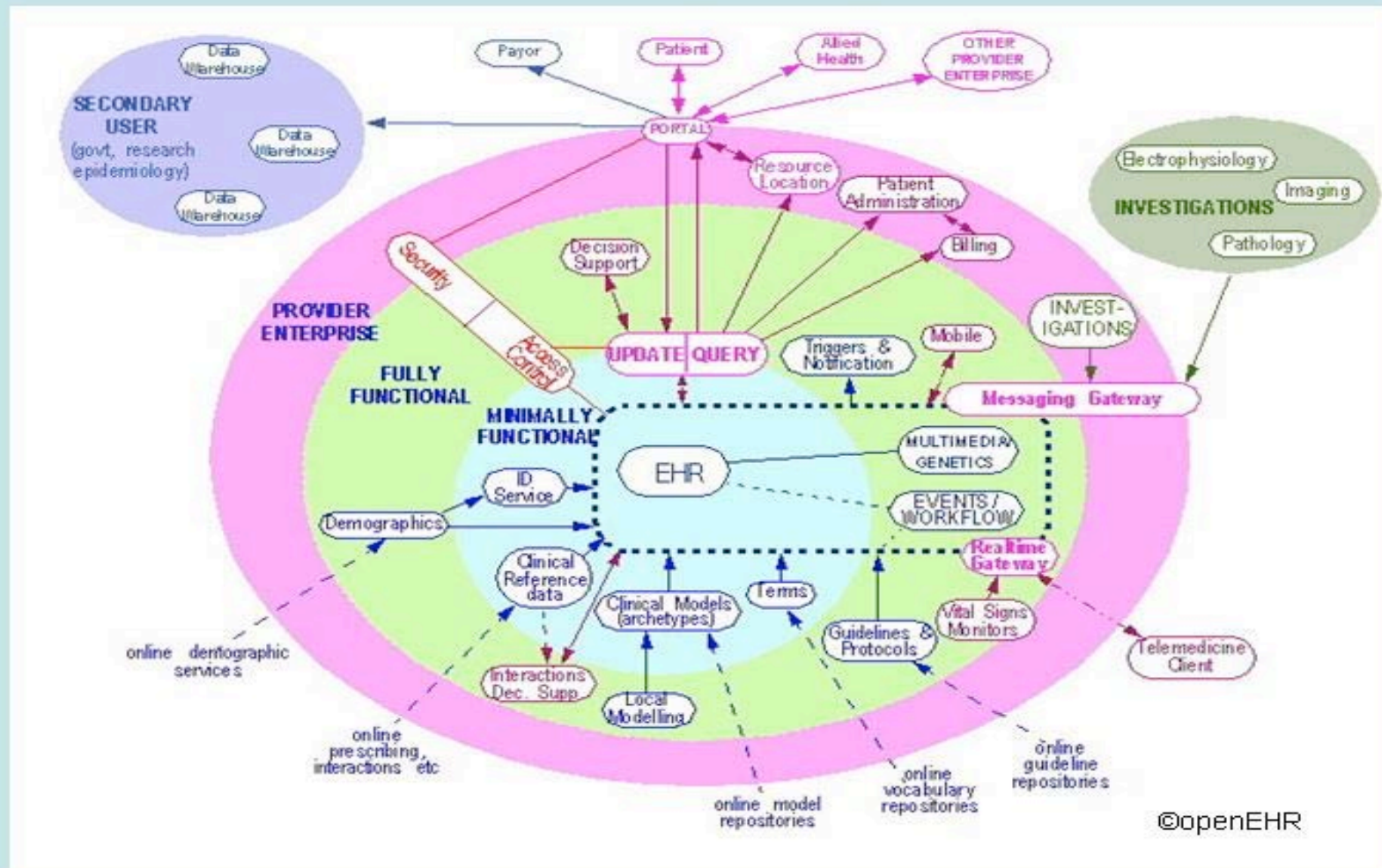
